Completion of Skate Ontario COVID-19 Waiver

ALL skaters, coaches, staff, board members, volunteers and officials **MUST** complete and sign the Skate Ontario Acknowledgement Release, Indemnity and Assumption of Risk waiver regarding COVID-19 prior to participating in any club activities with the Arthur & Area Skating club. Failure to do so means that the individual will not be allowed to participate in club/skating school activities.

this form will be given out to **ALL skaters prior to the start of our programs and must be returned on the first night of skating before skater(s) can participate in our programs

An Individual becomes unwell with symptoms of COVID-19

- Any individual that is registered with our club that has been tested for COVID-19 must **not** participate in club or skating school activities while waiting for the results of the test
- The clubs response team will consult the Session Participation tracking sheets to inform other club/skating school members who might have been in close contact with the individual if indicated
 - Any club members who were in close contact with the individual should **not** participate in club/skating activities and should follow public health guidelines until the diagnosis of COVID-19 is ruled out by health professional

An individual tests positive for COVID-19

- If an individual **tests positive for COVID-19**, they must inform a member of the clubs COVID-19 Oversight Group (please refer to contact list above)
- The COVID-19 Oversight Group will work where requested with the facility and public health officials to assist in contact tracing. The Session Participation tracking sheets may be used to assist public health officials in informing other club members who may have been in close contact with the individual
- Any club members who were in close contact with the individual should **not participate** in club/skating activities for 14 days and should follow public health guidelines regarding self-isolation and testing

- It is recommended to inform all club members of a positive COVID-19 result within the club/skating school setting
- The club will inform and work with the facility in the case of a positive COVID-19 result and determine if any additional cleaning/disinfecting should be performed as per the facility's guidelines
- The club will inform Skate Ontario of a positive COVID-19 diagnosis by emailing clubsupportservices@skateontario.org

Return to club/skating activities following illness

- If no test was performed, or the COVID-19 test was negative, the individual may only return to club/skating activities once they **no longer have any symptoms of COVID-19**. Refer to below link for list of signs/symptoms of COVID-19

Modification/restriction/postponing or canceling of club/skating school activities

- Based on the evolving COVID-19 pandemic, the club will be prepared to follow public health, municipal/provincial government and sport recommendations regarding modifying/restricting/postponing or canceling activities
 - Clubs members will be informed as soon as possible of any modifications/restrictions or cancelations
 - Our club will keep any modifications and restrictions in place until advised that it is safe to resume activities by public health, government or sport officials

Public Health Guidelines

Club members and families should follow **all public health guidelines regarding COVID-19.**

- Any club members who themselves have travelled outside of Canada, or has someone in their household who has travelled outside Canada **must self-isolate and not participate in club/skating school activities for 14 days**
- Any individual who has been exposed to someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19 should self-isolate and is **not permitted to participate in club/skating school activities for 14 days**
- Any individual with symptoms of COVID-19 is **not permitted to take part in club or skating school activities and inform the club by emailing one of the COVID-19 Oversight Group members provided above**
- Any individual who has someone in their household showing symptoms of COVID-19, should **not participate in club/skating school activities**

COVID-19 Communication Plan

1. Ensure up to date contact information for all club members is on-file
2. Distribute information via email and Arthur & Area Skating Club Facebook Group to ALL skating club members
3. Provide contact list for COVID-19 Oversight Group to ALL skating club members
4. Provide links to communication updates and COVID-19 information on our website for future reference by club members
5. Designate member of COVID-19 Oversight Group to follow up with any individuals who become unwell with symptoms of COVID-19 during club/skating activities
6. Daily Session Participation Tracking sheets will be stored at the arena in a designated area (to be determined with arena staff)
7. If it is determined that a club member has been tested for COVID-19, all club/skating members that may have been in close contact with that individual will be informed
8. Ensure the facility and Skate Ontario are informed if a club member is diagnosed with COVID-19 by emailing Tom Bowden tbowden@wellington-north.com and Skate Ontario clubsupportservices@skateontario.org
